



# **Guide to Bickerdike Advisory Resolutions**

## **1. What's an Advisory Resolution?**

- Organizational members are encouraged to submit advisory resolutions for the Bickerdike Redevelopment Corporation Annual Membership meeting. Advisory resolutions are written to reaffirm partnerships, campaigns, or work that Bickerdike has already done, is currently involved in or should be doing in the future. Advisory resolutions typically reflect the work that an organizational member has done or would like to do in coordination with Bickerdike.

## **2. Why are Advisory Resolutions important?**

- Advisory resolutions help influence what direction the organization takes in the upcoming year. Advisory resolutions are important in that they keep Bickerdike grounded and focused on the present needs of the community.

## **3. What are the guidelines for writing an Advisory Resolution?**

- Advisory resolutions are composed of two distinct parts, the “Whereas” section which focuses on what has been done and /or on existing partnerships and work and the “Therefore Resolved” section which proposes work that should be done or continued in the future.
- Resolutions should be no more than 4-5 paragraphs long and can be shorter than four paragraphs.
- Resolutions should be submitted no later than 3 weeks prior to the Bickerdike Annual Membership Meeting, which typically occurs on the first Saturday of December.

## **4. When and how are Advisory Resolutions presented?**

- Advisory resolutions are presented and voted on at Bickerdike's Annual Membership Meeting. The resolutions are read by the master/mistress of ceremonies and are included in member packet materials.

## **5. A sample Advisory Resolution follows: (see other side)**

**Sample Resolution**
